Articles to be furnished hereunder shall be manufactured, tested and inspected in accordance with drawing number *(30003) 3036AS175 Rev "A"*, it is the contractors responsibility upon award of contract to verify and manufacture to the latest revision for all required drawings, details, assemblies, and specifications referenced therein.

I. Quality/Inspection Requirements

- D. Production Lot Testing Applies

II. Supplemental Requirements

A. Additionally, para. 3.1-3.5, 5.1-5.2, 6.1-6.2 of MIL-Q-9858 or ISO 9000 equivalent apply.

B. The contractor shall include on the detailed process/operation sheets developed, a tracking method that is traceable to the contract, including all manufacturing sources performing processes/operations both those performed in-house and those outsourced . These sheets shall not be revised or altered after the successful completion of First Article and/or Production Lot Testing without approval from the Engineering Support Activity (ESA), via the PCO.

C. The Inspection Method Sheets, which list the characteristics of each item, produced under the contract shall have serial number traceability to the raw material, casting, or forging. In addition, the contractor is responsible for providing completed inspection method sheets showing the actual dimensions taken

D. Markings should be in accordance with MIL-STD-130. Method and location shall be in accordance with the drawing.

III. Mandatory Inspection Requirements

During production, mandatory inspection is required to be accomplished by the contractor, as follows:

- A. Level of Inspection (LOI):

1) Critical Characteristics: 100% inspection shall apply.

2) Major and Minor Characteristics - LOI shall be in accordance with a sampling plan acceptable to the QAR.

B. Critical Characteristics:

DRAWING (30003) 3036AS175 Rev "A",

Critical Characteristics:

(Shall be defined as below, unless defined by the Prime Contractor (30003))

Diametrical and liner dimensions having a total tolerance of 0.001 or less.

Surface finishes having a 16 value or less.

Any geometric feature control requirement with a total tolerance range of 0.002 or less.

Angular tolerances with a total range less than (1) one degree.

Threads specified to class (3) three or greater.

C. Major and Minor Characteristics:

1) Shall be defined by the contractor subject to QAR concurrence, unless defined on applicable drawings and associated specifications.

IV. Unless expressly provided for elsewhere in this Clause, equipment such as fixtures, jigs, dies, patterns, templates, Mylar's, special tooling, test equipment, or any other manufacturing aid required for the manufacture and/or testing of the subject items will not be provided by the Government and is the sole responsibility of the of the contractor. The foregoing applies notwithstanding any reference to such equipment or the furnishing thereof that may be contained in any drawing

FIRST ARTICLE TESTS REQUIRED (Government Testing(Contractors Facility)

I. First Article Inspection/Test Criteria:

The tests to be performed under the First Article approval clause of the contract are:

- A. Dimensional Check 100 % of finished part
- B. Form
- C. Compliance with drawing (30003) 3036AS175 Rev "A", and all details, assemblies, specifications referenced therein.
- D. Review documentation as provided under DD 1423 requirements.

In addition to the above tests, the First Articles to be delivered hereunder shall also be subjected to those tests that will demonstrate that the articles comply with contract requirements.

The contractor shall be responsible for providing necessary parts and repair of the First Article (s) during testing.

- II. **NOTIFICATION OF TESTING:** The contractor shall notify the PCO, ACO and QAR prior to conducting First Article Tests so that the Government may witness such testing:

- A. The QAR shall be present to witness all required Inspections/ Tests.

III. **Test Report:** The test report shall be in accordance with MIL- STD-831 and shall be submitted (2 copies) via the Cognizant CAO/QAR to the PCO. The CAO/QAR shall provide comments on Form DD 1222 (2 copies) which shall be forwarded with the test report. Approval of the test report is the PCO's responsibility. Upon notification of approval/conditional approval, the ACO shall execute the DD 250 to indicate Government acceptance of the test report.

IV. Disposition Sample(s)

- A. Sample(s) may be considered as production items under the contract provided the sample(s) can be refurbished to ready for issue (RFI) condition and provided the sample(s) have inspection approval of the cognizant QAR. Sample(s) may be shipped as Production items only after all other units required under the contract have been provided and are ready for shipment.

B. Test Sample :

The contractor shall deliver 10 unit(s) of the following: *(30003) 3036ASI75 Rev "A"*, as specified in this contract. At least fourteen (14) calendar days before the beginning of the First Article testing,

The contractor shall notify the contracting officer, in writing, of the time and location of the testing so that the Government may witness the tests.

The contractor shall submit the First Article Test Report within 15 calendar days from the date of testing to the contracting officer

The contractor shall mark the report "First Article Test Report" and cite the contract number and lot/item number. Review documentation as provided under the DD1423 requirements.

Within 45 calendar days after the Government receives the Inspection/Test report, the contracting officer shall notify the contractor, in writing, of the approval, conditional approval, or disapproval of the Inspection/Test report.

The notice of approval, conditional approval, or disapproval shall not relieve the contractor from complying with all requirements of the specifications and all other terms and conditions of this contract. A notice of conditional approval shall state any further action required of the contractor. A notice of disapproval shall cite reasons for disapproval.

If the Test Article is disapproved, the contractor, upon Government request shall repeat any or all Inspection/ Tests. After each request for additional tests, the contractor shall make any necessary changes, modifications, or repairs to the Test Article or select another Test Article For inspection/testing. All costs related to these tests are to be borne by the contractor, including any and all costs for additional tests following a disapproval. The contractor shall then conduct the tests and deliver another report to the Government under the terms and conditions and within the time specified in the paragraph above. The Government reserves the right to require An equitable adjustment of the contract price for any extension of the delivery schedule or for any additional costs to the Government related to these tests.

If the contractor fails to deliver any Test Article on time, or the contracting officer disapproves any Test Article, the contractor shall be deemed to have failed to make delivery within the meaning of the default clause of this contract.

Unless otherwise provided in the contract, and if the approved Test Article is not consumed or destroyed in testing, the contractor may deliver the approved Test Article as part of the contract quantity if it meets all contract requirements for acceptance.

If the Government does not act within the time specified in paragraph (C) above the contracting officer, shall, upon timely written request from the contractor, equitably adjust under the Changes clause of this contract the delivery or performance dates and/or the contract price, and any other contractual term affected by the delay.

Before First Article Approval, the acquisition of materials or components for, or the commencement of production or, the balance of the contract quantity is at the sole risk of the contractor. Before First Piece First Production Lot approval, the costs thereof shall not be allocated to this contract for 1) progress payments, or 2) termination settlements if the contract is terminated for the convenience of the Government. The contractor is responsible for providing operating and maintenance instructions, spare parts, and repair of the Test First Article.

PRODUCTION LOT TESTING REQUIREMENTS: (CONTRACTOR TESTING)

The material produced under contract shall be accepted by the cognizant CAO/QAR upon the successful completion of these requirements.

I. Production Lot Test Requirements

A. The cognizant CAO/QAR shall select two (10) item (s) at random from the production lot. In addition the QAR shall select one (10) item (s) at random from each successive lot or portion thereof.

B. Production Lot Testing to be completed during production after First Article Approval.

C. Sample (s) are to be unpainted. Corrosive areas to be coated with a light preservative.

II. The tests to be performed under the Production Lot Sample testing provisions of the contract are:

A. Compliance with drawing (30003) 3036AS175 Rev "A", and all specification referenced therein.

B. Dimensional Check

In addition to the above tests, the Production Lot Sample(s) to be delivered hereunder shall also be subjected to those tests, which will demonstrate, that the sample(s) comply with contract requirements.

III. Testing location

B. Shipping container marking: NON RFI

Within fifteen (15) days of completion of Production Lot Testing the CAO/QAR shall prepare and submit two (2) copies of their test report with conclusions and recommendations to the Contracting Officer.

Shipment and Distribution of Sample(s):

NOTIFICATION OF TESTING: The contractor shall notify the PCO, ACO and QAR prior to conducting Production Lot Tests so that the Government may witness such testing

A. The QAR shall be present to witness all required Inspections/ Tests.

B. Upon completion of Production Lot Testing, two (2) copies of the Material Inspection and Receiving report (DD form 250), bearing the QAR's signature and indication of preliminary inspection, shall be forwarded to the PCO / ACO. The envelopes shall be clearly marked, "DO NOT OPEN IN MAILROOM".

C. Sample(s) may be considered as production items under the contract provided sample(s) can be refurbished to ready For Issue (RFI) condition and provided sample(s) have inspection approval of the cognizant DCMAO. Sample(s) may be shipped as production items only after all other units required under the contract have been produced and are ready for shipment.

a. **Group I Definition** - Data which is ~~not~~ otherwise essential to the contractor performance of the primary contracted effort (production development, testing, and administration) but which is required by DD Form 1423

Estimated Price - Costs to be included under Group I are those applicable to preparing and assembling the data item in conformance with Government requirements, and the administration and other expenses related to reproducing and delivering such data items to the Government.

b. **Group II Definition** - Data which is essential to the performance of the primary contracted effort both the contractor is required to perform additional work to conform to Government requirements with regard to depth of content, format, frequency of submittal, preparation, control, or quality of the data item.

Estimated Price - Costs to be included under Group II are those incurred over and above the cost of the essential data item without conforming to Government requirement, and the administrative and other expenses related to reproducing and delivering such data item to the Government.

c. **Group III Definition** - Data which the contractor must develop for his internal use in performance of the primary contracted effort and does not require any substantial change to conform to Government requirements with regard to depth of content, format, frequency of submittal, preparation, control, and quality of the data item.

Estimated Price - Costs to be included under Group III are the administrative and other expenses related to reproducing and delivering such data item to the Government.

d. **Group IV Definition** - Data which is developed by the contractor as part of his normal operating procedures and his effort in supplying these data to the Government is minimal

Estimated Price - Group IV items should normally be shown on the DD Form 1423 at no cost.

Item 18. For each data item, enter an amount equal to that portion of the total price which is estimated to be attributable to the production development for the Government of that item of data. These estimated data prices shall be developed only from those costs which will be incurred as a direct result of the requirement to supply the data, over and above those costs which would otherwise be incurred in performance of the contract if not data were required. The estimated data prices shall not include any amount for rights in data. The Government's right to use the data shall be governed by the pertinent provisions of the contract
