Final Disposition Instructions for ALFOODACT 14-02, Rich SeaPak Corp.
Peeled and Deveined Frozen Shrimp.

1. Reference:

- a. DLAR 4155.26/AR40-660/NAVSUPINST 10110.8c/AFI 48-116/MCO 10110.38C, DOD Hazardous Food and Nonprescription Drug Recall system.
- b. Allied Communications Publication 121, US SUPP-1(F).

2. Previous laboratory tests of 24-ounce bags of peeled and deveined frozen shrimp from Rich SeaPak Corporation (by the U.S. Army Veterinary Command, Food Analysis and Diagnostic Laboratory, Ft. Sam Houston, TX, and by the FDA Kansas City Branch Laboratory), revealed the presence of chloramphenicol. Federal regulations prohibit its use in food-producing animals and animal-feed products because it has not been possible to identify a safe level of human exposure to chloramphenicol. It is DSCP's recommendation that if still found in military supply channels, the product be returned to the manufacturer, via the distributor.

4. Distribution: Products were distributed to, but not limited to, DeCA retail stores.

5. Directives for Message Recipients:

A. Accountable personnel will:

(1) Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items.

(2) Secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use of the item, while awaiting return of product to the manufacturer.

B. Further Instructions:

(1) Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. Information shall be forwarded by priority message to this center.

(2) As a potential for adverse health consequences exists, activities known to have issued/sold the above items are authorized to notify their customers.
