

**ALFOODACT 05/03**  
**Chicken of the Sea Tuna, Plastic Pack (Expanded) DATE ISSUED: 11 April 2003**

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**1. Reference:**

- a. DLAR 4155.26/AR40-660/NAVSUPINST 10110.8c/AFI 48-116/MCO 10110.38C, DOD Hazardous Food and Nonprescription Drug Recall system.
  - b. Allied Communications Publication 121, US SUPP-1(F).
2. Based on information received from the USS ABRAHAM LINCOLN, the DSCP Consumer Safety Office is recalling two additional lots of **Chicken of the Sea tuna**. Please note that the additional lot numbers are identical to a previously recalled tuna product (ALFOODACT 02-03), with the exception of the 4th position in the product code. The 4th position represents a particular batch of product. This recall is specific to 43-ounce plastic tuna packs.

**3. Production Dates/Identifying Codes:**

**4. Manufacturer:** The label for the product reads as follows:  
Distributed by Chicken of the Sea, International  
San Diego, CA 92121

**5. Distribution** Products were shipped from the manufacturer to Cavalier Marine Supply in Norfolk, VA on 12/13/02. Specific distribution of the product from Norfolk, VA is unknown.

**6. Reason for Recall:** Product may contain high levels of histamine.

**7. Directives for Message Recipients:**

A. Accountable personnel will:

(1) Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items.

(2) Secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use of the item. **RETURN recalled product to manufacturer via the distributor.**

B. Further Instructions:

(1) Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. Information shall be forwarded by priority message to this center.

(2) As a potential for adverse health consequences exists, activities known to have issued/sold the above items are authorized to notify their customers.
