Updated List Of Countries Prohibited From Importing Ruminant (Cattle, Sheep, Goats)
Meats And Meat Products Into The United States

This message is an update of the list of countries prohibited from the importation of ruminant meats and meat products into the United States due to the potential infection with Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE). Procurement agencies need to ensure that they are in compliance with the prohibition against the purchase or sale of ruminant meat or meat products from counties on this list IAW the Joint Staff Message dated 011856Z Feb 01, Subject: DoD Food Procurement Policy and Compliance with 9 CFR 94.18(a)(1).

3. CANADA is now included on the list of countries prohibited from the importation of ruminant meats and meat products into the United States.

4. The updated list of countries is as follows: Albania, Andorra, Austria, Belgium, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Canada, Croatia, The Czech Republic, Denmark, The Federal Republic Of Yugoslavia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, The Republic Of Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, The Former Yugoslav Republic Of Macedonia, Monaco, The Netherlands, Norway, Oman, Poland, Portugal, Romania, San Marino, The Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, And The United Kingdom.
