2. BACKGROUND:

On 20 March 2004, a customer at Camp Virginia DFAC in Kuwait found metal shavings in their breakfast burrito. To this point, the incident appears to be an isolated one. The company has voluntarily agreed to recall the products in question.

7. REASON FOR RECALL: Products may contain metal shavings.

(1) Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items.

(2) Secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use of the item.

(3) Accountable Activities should arrange a return of the recalled products to the manufacturer, by means of the Prime Vendor Representative.

(4) Products previously placed on "Medical Hold" that do not match the product identified in this message should be released immediately, and returned to inventory for normal issue/sale/use.
