

SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 016-2004- *King Oscar Brand Fillets of Anchovies in Olive Oil (EXPANDED)*
DATE ISSUED: December 2, 2004

1. REFERENCE:

c. ALFOODACT 015-2004: *King Oscar Brand Rolled Fillets of Anchovies in Pure Olive Oil (with capers)*, issued on December 1, 2004.

2. BACKGROUND:

The Defense Supply Center Philadelphia (DSCP) Consumer Safety Office has learned that additional product codes and product varieties of the King Oscar Brand anchovies are implicated in the original ALFOODACT message (Refer to ALFOODACT 015-2004, issued on December 1, 2004). As a result, DSCP is expanding the scope of the original message.

3. PRODUCTION DATES/IDENTIFYING CODES:

The following information is pertinent to the recalled product:

Item Description: **All varieties of King Oscar Brand Anchovies in Olive Oil**

Size: 2-ounce (56 g) extruded pop-top can

Product Code: **All product codes**

UPC: **All UPCs**

Product cans are reported to be labeled with the following distributors, but please note that other distributors may be involved that have not yet been identified:

4. **DISTRIBUTION:** Found in DeCA Commissaries- Alaska; product may be in other locations as well.

5. **QUANTITY:** Unknown

6. **REASON FOR RECALL:** The product **may** pose a potential food safety risk.

7. **INSTRUCTIONS FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:**

(1) Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items, and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use of the item.

(2) **Ships at sea** are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. Information shall be forwarded by priority message to this center.

(3) This ALFOODACT applies only to product description and identifying codes outlined in Paragraph (3) of this message.

(4) The DSCP Consumer Safety Office will initiate a follow on ALFOODACT message to provide specific disposition instructions, as soon as laboratory results are available, thus concluding the message.
