

SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 002-2005- Pancake Mix, Regular or Buttermilk, and Corn Bread Mix, No. 10 size can (Final Disposition Instructions for ALFOODACT 013-2004)
DATE ISSUED: January 4, 2005

1. REFERENCE:

2. BACKGROUND:

The purpose of this recall is to provide final disposition instructions for ALFOODACT 013-2004, issued on November 19, 2004. The Department of Defense Veterinary Food Analysis and Diagnostic Laboratory at Fort Sam Houston, TX analyzed the bakery products. Laboratory results revealed that the swollen cans are indicative of a chemical reaction most likely caused by storage of products under elevated temperatures. In summary, except for obviously swollen cans, the products are wholesome and fit for their intended purpose. See paragraph 7. for specific disposition instructions.

6. **REASON FOR RECALL**: The product may pose a potential food safety risk.

7. **DISPOSITION INSTRUCTIONS FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS**:

(1) Accountable activities should inspect bakery products currently on "Medical Hold," as a result of ALFOODACT 013-2004, as well as those products identified after the publication of ALFOODACT 013-2004. Those cans that are obviously swollen, have broken seals, or other abnormalities, should not be used. They should be disposed of/destroyed, in accordance with local policies. **Return to inventory (as soon as possible) those products that appear normal for routine use/issue.**

(2) **Ships at sea** are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. Information shall be forwarded by priority message to this center.
