

SUBJECT - ALFOODACT 012-2005: Ultra-High Temperature (UHT) 2% White Milk, 5-Gallon Bag in a Box

Date Issued - July 13, 2005

1. REFERENCE:

a. DLAR 4155.26/AR 40-660/NAVSUPINST 10110.8c/AFI 48-116/MCO 10110.38c, DOD Hazardous Food & Nonprescription Drug Recall System.

2. BACKGROUND:

This recall is prompted by a customer complaint at the U.S. Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba of curdled/sour milk. The manufacturer of the UHT (Ultra-High Temperature) milk discovered a mechanical problem in the production line that contributed to the "curdling" of the milk products. Gossner Foods has initiated an "internal" recall of the product, which includes the issuance of a credit to the Accountable Activity for the potentially affected lots.

3. PRODUCTION DATES/IDENTIFYING CODES:

5. DISTRIBUTION: Distributor: (Diversified Foods)- We have information that products were shipped to the IJ Company (Valdosta, GA), SYSCO of Hampton Roads (Suffolk, VA) and U.S. Foodservice in California. The items could have been shipped to other locations, as well.

6. RECALL CLASSIFICATION: Class I/(Institutional Use)

7. QUANTITY RECALLED: Unknown

8. REASON FOR RECALL: The product quality may be affected due to curdling/souring.

9. INSTRUCTIONS FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:

(1) Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use of the item.

(2) **Ships at sea** are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. Information shall be forwarded by priority message to this center.

(3) Accountable activities should return recalled product to the manufacturer through the appropriate distribution channels.

(4) This ALFOODACT applies only to product description and identifying codes outlined in paragraph/number 3. of this message.
