The products subject to recall are:

- \* 16 oz. packages of "Chef Pronto, Tortellini with Grilled Chicken and Sun-dried Tomatoes." The labels carry a code of "064871."
- \* 12 oz. packages of "Chef Pronto, Grilled Chicken with Balsamic Vinegar and Rosemary." The labels carry a code of "064914."
- \* 12 oz. packages of "Chef Pronto, Grilled Lemon Pepper Chicken." The labels carry a code of "064916."
- \* 12 oz. packages of "Chef Pronto, Grilled Chicken Strips." The labels carry a code of "064873."

All products bear the establishment number "P-19629" inside the USDA seal of inspection.

**PROBLEM/REASON FOR RECALL:** The products may be contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes*.

**HOW/WHEN DISCOVERED:** FSIS sampling returned a positive result for *Listeria monocytogenes* on July 28, 2005.
