This report was updated December 3, 2005 to alert consumers to the fact that Ham Cracker Crunchers produced on FEB 06 AND FEB 09 are also subject to recall. The product code is 4660003427. Turkey Cracker Crunchers produced on FEB 09 are not subject to recall, contrary to what was stated in the December 1 release. The product code is 4660003428.

Turkey, Ham and Bologna Lunch Makers® Meals

The products may be contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes*.
