

SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 006-2007 Kraft Recalls Oscar Mayer/Louis Rich Chicken Breast Strips and Cuts due to Listeria Monocytogenes

Date Issued: February 23, 2007

1. REFERENCE:

2. BACKGROUND :

On February 18th, our external manufacturer, Carolina Culinary Foods (CCF), issued a recall for the *Oscar Mayer/Louis Rich* Chicken Breast Strips – Grilled, with a “Best When Used By” date of 19 APR 2007 because of a finding of *Listeria monocytogenes* in a single package. While they’ve had no reports of listeriosis associated with the February 18th recall and have had no other findings of Listeria in our product, their investigation has led them to conclude that they should recall all their products made at that facility as a precautionary measure.

3. PRODUCTION DATES/IDENTIFYING CODES:

The front of each package bears the establishment number "P-19676."

All code dates of *Oscar Mayer/Louis Rich* Chicken Breast Strips and *Oscar Mayer/Louis Rich* Chicken Breast Cuts are being recalled for the following:

6. REASON FOR RECALL: Listeria Monocytogenes

7. INSTRUCTIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:

(1) Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use of the item.

(2) Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. In order to get credit please use a SF 364 and forward to your supporting FISC and copy furnished to NAVSUP 51. Your supporting FISC should forward to the account manager at DSCP. The form should include the number of the recall authorizing the survey action. Home ported ships/gallies will utilize DD form 1149 to transfer w/ reimbursement to the PV. The PV will submit credit invoice to the account manager at DSCP.

(3) **POSITIVE RESPONSES** should be reported to Accountable Officers of that facility. Return recalled product to the manufacturer through the appropriate distribution channels for replacement and/or credit. It may be more feasible for overseas location to seek reimbursement/credit and destroy at location.

(4) Unless otherwise specified above, **POSITIVE and NEGATIVE RESPONSES** directly to DSCP Consumer Safety Officer (CSO) are **NOT** required.

(5) When corresponding with DSCP concerning this message please include this message's subject in your subject line.
