2. BACKGROUND:

ALFOODACT 007-2008 which placed Cuisine Solutions Pollock in Creamy Dijon Sauce on hold because of underprocessing initiated a Special Audit that was conducted by Veterinary Command. The Special Audit included microbial analysis. The results from microbial laboratory testing were negative. Product is released from hold and can be utilized as intended.

19 February 2008- ALFOODACT 007-2008: Cuisine Solutions is withdrawing the following product due to under processing: Pollock in Creamy Dijon Sauce.
