

SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 022-2009 Expansion of ALFOODACT 018-2009 Wells' Dairy Expands Voluntary Recall of Select Blue Bunny® Products

2. BACKGROUND:

Yesterday as a precaution Wells' Dairy voluntarily recalled one lot of Blue Bunny Personal's Bunny Tracks (80024 D19114 "Best Used By" date 09/11/09) and all Blue Bunny No Sugar Added Reduced Fat Bunny Tracks ice cream sold at retail and foodservice levels in 1.75 quart plastic containers with all codes displaying "Best Used By" dates prior to January 29, 2010. Best used by date is located on the bottom of the carton.

3. PRODUCTION DATES/IDENTIFYING CODES:

Blue Bunny Personal's® Bunny Tracks® 8 fl oz. sold at retail and foodservice levels to include Lot Number 80030 "Best Used By" date 11/17/2009. The lot number can be found printed on the side of the carton.

5. DISTRIBUTION: Nationwide

6. REASON FOR ACTION: Salmonella

7. INSTRUCTIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:

- a. Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use and return to vendor when feasible. POSITIVE FINDINGS should be reported to Accountable Officers/Vendor Representatives of that facility. Accountable Officer/Agency representatives/Buyers/Contracting Officers should seek refund/credit/replacement through the normal distribution channel with which the product was received (i.e. Distribution Centers, Prime Vendors, Manufacturers).
- b. Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. In order to get credit please use a SF 364 and forward to your supporting FISC and copy furnished to NAVSUP 51. Your supporting FISC should forward to the account manager at DSCP. The form should include the number of the recall authorizing the survey action. Home ported ships/gallies will utilize DD form 1149 to transfer w/ reimbursement to the PV. The PV will submit credit invoice to the account manager at DSCP.

c. Unless otherwise specified above, POSITIVE and NEGATIVE RESPONSES directly to DSCP Consumer Safety Officer (CSO) are NOT required.
