

**SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 040-2009 Prairie Farms Dairy Announces Voluntary Nationwide Recall Because of Possible Health Risk**

**2. BACKGROUND:**

Prairie Farms Dairy has initiated a recall of two of its ice cream products because they have the potential to be contaminated with Salmonella, an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. The Peanut Corporation of America (PCA), a supplier to Prairie Farms Dairy, initiated a recall of the peanut ingredient used to make the recalled products, which is why we are conducting this recall.

**3. PRODUCTION DATES/IDENTIFYING CODES:**

The peanut-containing ice creams included in this recall are:

- Half-Gallon Central Dairy Candy Bar Whirl Ice Cream, Central Dairy, Jefferson City, MO, UPC 073948-06313, Lots 15108 through 01209
- 56 oz. Old Recipe Candy Bar Ice Cream, Prairie Farms, Carlinville, IL, UPC 72730-72008, Best by: April 14, 2008 through January 15, 2010

**5. DISTRIBUTION:** These ice creams are known to be sold in Alabama, Arkansas, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia in retail stores.

**6. REASON FOR ACTION:** Salmonella

**7. INSTRUCTIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:**

- a. Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use. POSITIVE FINDINGS should be reported to Accountable Officers/Vendor Representatives of that facility. Accountable Officer/Agency representatives/Buyers/Contracting Officers should seek refund/credit/replacement through the normal distribution channel with which the product was received (i.e. Distribution Centers, Prime Vendors, Manufacturers).

b. Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. In order to get credit please use a SF 364 and forward to your supporting FISC and copy furnished to NAVSUP 51. Your supporting FISC should forward to the account manager at DSCP. The form should include the number of the recall authorizing the survey action. Home ported ships/gallies will utilize DD form 1149 to transfer w/ reimbursement to the PV. The PV will submit credit invoice to the account manager at DSCP.

c. Unless otherwise specified above, POSITIVE and NEGATIVE RESPONSES directly to DSCP Consumer Safety Officer (CSO) are NOT required.
