

**SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 048-2009 Wonder Ice Cream Company Announces Nationwide Voluntary Recall of Candy Blast 10oz Cups Because of Possible Health Risk**

**2. BACKGROUND:**

Wonder Ice Cream Company has issued a voluntary nationwide recall of its' Candy Blast 10oz Ice Cream Cups with manufacturing codes ending in 07 or 08. This recalled product contain peanut ingredients supplied by Peanut Corporation of America and may be contaminated with Salmonella. This recall has been prompted by Peanut Corporation of America's recall of all peanut products manufactured in their Blakely, Georgia facility since Jan. 1, 2007.

No illnesses have been reported to date in connection with this product.

**3. PRODUCTION DATES/IDENTIFYING CODES:**

Candy Blast 10oz Cups

The recalled products can be identified (UPC code 2391116101) with a manufacturing code ending in 07 or 08.

The manufacturing code is the 5 digit number printed vertically on the side of the cup just below the top rim.

These products are sold as single serving cups in retail freezer display cases and from vending trucks. No other Wonder Ice Cream products are part of this recall.

**6. REASON FOR ACTION:** Salmonella

**7. INSTRUCTIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:**

- a. Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use. POSITIVE FINDINGS should be reported to Accountable Officers/Vendor Representatives of that facility. Accountable Officer/Agency representatives/Buyers/Contracting Officers should seek

refund/credit/replacement through the normal distribution channel with which the product was received (i.e. Distribution Centers, Prime Vendors, Manufacturers).

b. Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. In order to get credit please use a SF 364 and forward to your supporting FISC and copy furnished to NAVSUP 51. Your supporting FISC should forward to the account manager at DSCP. The form should include the number of the recall authorizing the survey action. Home ported ships/gallies will utilize DD form 1149 to transfer w/ reimbursement to the PV. The PV will submit credit invoice to the account manager at DSCP.

c. Unless otherwise specified above, POSITIVE and NEGATIVE RESPONSES directly to DSCP Consumer Safety Officer (CSO) are NOT required.
