

**Subject:** ALFOODACT 077-2009 Otis Spunkmeyer, Inc. Announces Voluntary Recall of Three (3) Fully-Baked Peanut Butter Cookie

2. BACKGROUND:

Otis Spunkmeyer, Inc. today announced a limited, voluntary recall of three (3) fully-baked peanut butter cookie products supplied by a third-party contract manufacturer to the Company in 2008.

The company has received no information that the three (3) recalled products have caused illness or are defective in any way, and has no reason to believe that there is a public safety issue associated with the recalled products. We are taking this action solely as a precaution because the external manufacturer sourced roasted peanuts from Plainview Peanut Company of Plainview, Texas, a subsidiary of Peanut Corporation of America (PCA).

3. PRODUCTION DATES/IDENTIFYING CODES:

The recalled products are: (XXX = variable for Julian Date)

Item Code 57505, Thaw & Serve 2 oz./6-pack peanut butter cookies; Lot Codes 8QXXX and 8PXXX; UPC Code 10-01308-757505-4;

Item Code 57605, Thaw & Serve 2 oz./individually wrapped peanut butter cookies; Lot Codes 8QXXX and 8PXXX; UPC Code 10-01308-757605-1;

Item Code 57805, Thaw & Serve 4 oz./individually wrapped peanut butter cookies; Lot Codes 8QXXX and 8PXXX; UPC Code 10-01308-757805-5.

No other products of the Company, including frozen cookie dough, muffins, or Chippery brand products, are subject to this voluntary recall.

6. REASON FOR ACTION: Salmonella

7. INSTRUCTIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:

- a. Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use. POSITIVE FINDINGS should be reported to Accountable Officers/Vendor Representatives of that facility. Accountable Officer/Agency representatives/Buyers/Contracting Officers should seek refund/credit/replacement through the normal distribution channel with which the product was received (i.e. Distribution Centers, Prime Vendors, Manufacturers).
  - b. Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. In order to get credit please use a SF 364 and forward to your supporting FISC and copy furnished to NAVSUP 51. Your supporting FISC should forward to the account manager at DSCP. The form should include the number of the recall authorizing the survey action. Home ported ships/gallies will utilize DD form 1149 to transfer w/ reimbursement to the PV. The PV will submit credit invoice to the account manager at DSCP.
  - c. Except for Prime Vendors, POSITIVE and NEGATIVE RESPONSES directly to DSCP Consumer Safety Officer (CSO) are NOT required. Other agencies such as DeCA, AAFES, MWR, VA, MCCS, etc. should report NEGATIVE and POSITIVE responses as directed by their headquarters' policy.
