

Subject: ALFOODACT 089-2009 Deluxe Ice Cream Co., A Subsidiary Of Matterhorn Group Inc., Expands Recall To Include Additional Codes Of Recalled Products

2. BACKGROUND:

DELUXE ICE CREAM CO., of Salem Oregon, is expanding its recall to include Tin Roof Sundae, Goo Goo Cluster, Candy Bar packaged ice cream products, and QC 24 pack Sundae cone, because they were manufactured with peanuts recalled by Peanut Corporation of America because they have the potential to be contaminated with Salmonella.

No known illnesses have been reported to date in connection with any of these products. The expansion of the recall was initiated after it was determined that the peanuts supplied to Parker Products for their production of chocolate covered peanuts were manufactured using peanuts from Peanut Corporation of America's Blakely facility. Deluxe Ice Cream has informed FDA of its actions and is fully cooperating with the Agency.

3. PRODUCTION DATES/IDENTIFYING CODES:

The expanded product recall includes the following PRODUCTS WITH LOT CODES OF 7316 TO 9028, in addition to previously recalled codes 8212 to 9028. The lot code on half gallon (64 fl oz) packages can be found in the upper left corner adjacent to the nutritional panel. Lot code on 3 gallon tubs can be found on the lid. Lot code for 24 pack Sundae cones can be found on the top flap of the case.

7. INSTRUCTIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:

- a. Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use. POSITIVE FINDINGS should be reported to the Contracting Officers or Accountable Officers/Vendor Representatives of that facility. Accountable Officer/Agency representatives/Buyers/Contracting Officers should seek refund/credit/replacement through the normal distribution channel with which the product was received (i.e. Distribution Centers, Prime Vendors, Manufacturers, etc.).
- b. Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. In order to get credit please use a SF 364 and forward to your supporting FISC and copy furnished to NAVSUP 51. Your supporting FISC should forward to the account manager at DSCP. The form should include the number of the recall authorizing the survey action. Home ported ships/gallies will utilize DD form 1149 to transfer w/ reimbursement to the PV. The PV will submit credit invoice to the account manager at DSCP.
- c. Except for Prime Vendors, POSITIVE and NEGATIVE RESPONSES directly to DSCP Consumer Safety Officer (CSO) are NOT required. Prime Vendors should report finding to their assigned Contracting Officer and courtesy copy the Consumer Safety Office (dscpconssafofc@dla.mil). Other agencies such as DeCA, AAFES, MWR, VA, MCCS, etc. should report POSITIVE and NEGATIVE responses to their agencies recall coordinator.
