**SUPPLIES OR SERVICES AND PRICES**

**Delivery Points:**

Zone 1 – Anchorage  
Zone 2 – Fairbanks

**Delivery Period:** 28 August 2005 through 26 August 2006

**FOB Terms:** FOB destination for all items.

**Prices:**

The unit price is determined by adding the "*Delivered Price*" and the "*Distribution Price*". The Delivered Price consists of the cost of the product delivered to the plant in Washington, plus all barge costs associated with delivery to the customer in Alaska. Barge costs per pound at time of offer were:

- Canned and Dry, Chemicals, Supplies and Equipment
- Dairy, Poultry, Fresh and Frozen Meat
- Frozen Beverage
- Produce
- Seafood
- Other Frozen

The Distribution Price will remain fixed for each one-year term of the contract. If the Government determines to invoke the options, the Distribution Prices will remain unchanged. Distribution Prices are identical for both Zones. See Attachment 1 for Distribution Category Prices.

The total estimated dollar value of the base term of this contract is \$5,800,000. This contract contains a guaranteed minimum of 25% of the estimated dollar value, or \$1,450,000. The maximum ceiling will be 125% of the estimated dollar value. In the event of emergencies or mobilization, the government reserves the

right to unilaterally execute an alternative maximum ceiling of 300% of this estimated dollar value per contract period of this acquisition.

**PACKAGING AND MARKING**

All packaging and packing shall be in accordance with good commercial practice. Labeling shall be in accordance with commercial labeling complying with the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act and regulations promulgated thereunder. Shipping containers shall be in compliance with the National Motor Freight Classification and Uniform Freight Classification.

**INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE**

Inspection and Acceptance of products will be performed at destination. The inspection is normally limited to identity, count and condition; however, this may be expanded if deemed necessary by either the military veterinary inspector or the dining facility manager.

All deliveries are subject to military veterinary inspection. In addition, the delivery vehicles will be inspected for cleanliness and condition.

The authorized receiving official at each delivery point is responsible for inspecting and accepting products as they are delivered. The invoice/delivery ticket shall not be signed prior to the inspection of each product. All overages/shortages/returns are to be noted on the delivery ticket by receiving official and truck driver. A signature on the delivery ticket/invoice denotes acceptance of the product. No invoice may be submitted for payment until acceptance is verified.
